

Float the Ark

How precious is Your steadfast love, O God! Psalm 36:7

Supply List + Small kiddie pool, bucket or tub

+ Boat

+ Blindfold

+ Large bucket full of water

+ Larch plastic cup

Getting Ready

- 1. Set up an empty kiddie pool, bucket or tub. Place a plastic boat in the middle of each dry pool.
- 2. Place a bucket filled with water, a large plastic cup, and a blindfold a good distance away from the empty pool.

Let's Play!

- 1. Have players line up and blindfold the first player in line.
- 2. The second player in line acts as their guide to fill the cup, run to the pool and dump the water.
- 3. They run back to the line and the guide gets blindfolded, while the next player in line becomes the guide.
- 4. Players continue until they have enough water in the pool to float the ark.

Bible Connection Questions

Why did Noah and his family need to build an ark?

Do you think it was hard for Noah to trust God to save him and his family during the flood? Why?

How hard was it to trust your guide when you were blindfolded? What could have gone wrong?

Noah didn't know where he was going. Is it ever hard to trust God because you couldn't see Him?

God promised Noah that He would keep Noah and his family safe. What does God promise you?
