3 4	TO AMEND CHURCH-CA	STATUTORY BYLAW 9.01 OF THE 2017 HANDBOOK OF LUTHERAN
5 6 7	WHEREAS	the uncertainties and restrictions resulting from the present COVID19 pandemic bring into question the wisdom or even the possibility of holding an in-person Convention of Lutheran Church-Canada, scheduled for June of 2021; and
8 9 10 11 12 13	WHEREAS	the purpose of holding a Convention is not simply for conducting the business of the church: the elections to various offices and positions, making amendments to the Handbook, taking action on overtures and reports, and so on, but is also an important opportunity to physically gather together as contemplated in Synodical Bylaw 2.01: "The Convention shall afford an opportunity for worship, nurture, inspiration, fellowship, and the communication of vital information"; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS	changing the June 2021 Convention from an in-person to a virtual or online Convention would result in pastor and lay delegates being unable to physically gather together for a period of eight years; and
17 18	WHEREAS	postponing the June 2021 Convention to 2022 requires a change to Statutory Bylaw 9.01 of the 2017 Handbook of LCC; therefore be it
19 20 21 22 23 24 25	RESOLVED	that Statutory Bylaw 9.01, as it currently reads: "A Convention shall be held every four years at a time and place determined by the Board" be amended to read: "A Convention shall be held every four years at a time and place determined by the Board. The Convention may, however, be postponed due to extraordinary events (acts of God, war, terrorism, government regulations, disaster, strikes, civil disorder, pandemic, etc.). In such a case, the Convention is to be held as soon as feasibly possible."

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6 7 8 9	WHEREAS	the Board of Directors has, through an overwhelming majority, voted in favour of postponing the June 2021 Convention and has recommended extending the term of office for all those serving elected offices or appointed positions for one year, until the regular convention of the Synod can be held; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS	it is important for the mission and ministry of the church that the synod continue to have the benefit and blessing of those leaders who have been elected to serve; and
13 14	WHEREAS	there are legal requirements under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act regarding the election of the <i>directors</i> of the corporation; therefore be it
15 16 17	RESOLVED	that the Synod, in the Special Convention, reelect the Board of Directors for the next year, with the term to end after the next regular convention of the Synod; and be it further
18 19 20	RESOLVED	that the term of office of all other elected or appointed positions being automatically extended until the next regular convention, in accordance with provisions of Statutory Bylaw 10.03 and Synodical Bylaw 2.61; and be it finally
21 22 23	RESOLVED	that any office holder who is unable to fulfill this extended term be thanked for their service, and that the offices and positions be filled by the Board of Directors for this vacancy period.
