

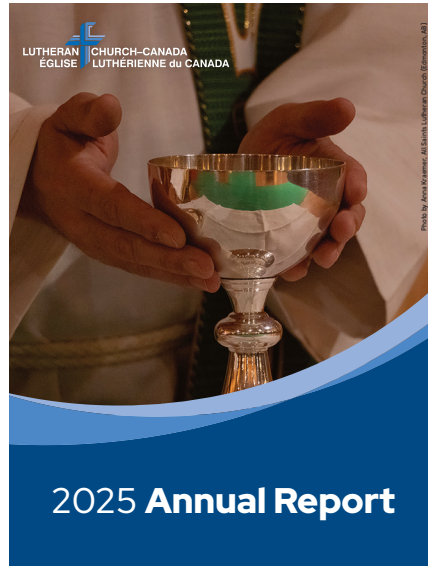


# 2025 Annual Report Highlights

Lutheran Church–Canada’s 2025 Annual Report highlights our shared mission and ministry across Canada and around the world.

**MISSIONS ABROAD** | By the grace of God, the Church is ever in motion—called, sent, and sustained by the Living Christ to bring His life-giving Gospel to those He sends us to serve. In Cambodia, theological education is forming faithful pastors and deaconesses. In Thailand, the Church celebrated 20 years of mission with growing outreach and leadership. The Church in Nicaragua, through its 22 Lutheran Day Schools and the Bread of Life Feeding Program, is nurturing children both physically and spiritually. In Ukraine, despite the ongoing war, Word and Sacrament ministry remains strong. Across all mission fields, LCC remains committed to sound theological training as the heart of its international witness.

**MISSIONS AT HOME** | LCC’s domestic mission efforts are bearing fruit in communities nationwide. Ministry among ethnic groups—including Ethiopian, Sudanese, and Chinese communities—is expanding, and outreach to First Nations communities is advancing through strategic partnerships. Initiatives like Street Reach Ministry in Regina bring Christ’s mercy to the streets, while French-language ministry continues to serve both Canadian and



global Francophone populations. Regional Mission and Ministry Councils (RMMCs) play a key role in supporting congregational vitality and expanding mission outreach across all regions.

**FINANCES AND OTHER REPORTS** | LCC’s 2024–2025 fiscal year concluded with a surplus, thanks largely to late-year unrestricted gifts. Congregational remittances reached their highest level since 2019, with strong support also coming from individual donors and auxiliary organizations. Expenses were well aligned with the approved budget, and reduced pension costs provided additional flexibility. Looking ahead, the FY2026 budget includes strategic investments in mission staff, communications, and Synod-wide initiatives, all guided by the Purpose and Priorities Planning process.
