<b>Teaching Points</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• God had promised to send a prophet</li> <li>• This prophet, John, told of one “mightier than I”</li> <li>• The one “mightier than I”, was first promised to Adam and Eve.</li> <li>• The one “mightier than I” is Jesus</li> <li>• Jesus is God’s Son</li> <li>• Jesus’ Baptism is just the beginning of His ministry</li> <li>• Jesus is already taking the sinner’s place</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus was already seen as something special: He had disciples, and His mother knew he was.</li> <li>• He was at a wedding that ran out of wine</li> <li>• Jesus first miracle is turning water into wine</li> <li>• Not just a little water but about 200 litres!</li> <li>• And it is the very best wine!</li> <li>• Jesus showed His glory, and the disciples believed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• While His disciples were sailing in a storm Jesus walks on the water</li> <li>• The disciples can’t believe it’s Him and are scared</li> <li>• Jesus gives Peter the power to walk on the water but Peter doubts when he sees the winds and waves and sinks.</li> <li>• Jesus saves Peter, takes him to the boat, and stops the storm.</li> <li>• “Truly you are the Son of God!”</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus is betrayed by Judas (a disciple)</li> <li>• Jesus is put on trial by the Jewish Council, Herod, and Pontius Pilate.</li> <li>• Jesus is beaten and mocked</li> <li>• The people can choose to release Jesus or Barabbas (a known killer), and they choose Jesus to die</li> <li>• Pilate finds no fault in Jesus but hands him over to be crucified.</li> <li>• Jesus dies on the cross and is buried</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Some of Jesus’ loved ones go to His tomb</li> <li>• But it’s empty, Jesus body isn’t there, and an angel tells them that Jesus has risen from the dead!</li> <li>• Jesus meets them, shows He is alive, and tells them not to be afraid.</li> <li>• Jesus sends the women to bring the Good News.</li> <li>• More people will see Him. (see 1 Cor. 15:3-8)</li> </ul>
<b>Application Points</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• God sent His Son Jesus just as he had promised. God always keeps His promises</li> <li>• Jesus is not an ordinary man, He is both Man and God!</li> <li>• Baptism is also an awesome beginning for us!</li> <li>• Baptism is a means of grace</li> <li>• Titus 3:5-7</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus shows his care by saving the bride and groom from embarrassment</li> <li>• Jesus provides through miraculous means.</li> <li>• Jesus cares and provides for us.</li> <li>• He gives us the very best: Himself.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus shows He is all-powerful in many ways: walks on water, enables Peter to do the same, and calms the storm.</li> <li>• Jesus shows His incredible love to Peter even though he had worries and doubts (and He does the same for us)!</li> <li>• The disciples have no doubts about who Jesus is anymore</li> <li>• We can trust in Jesus to save us.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus could have stopped the trial at any point.</li> <li>• He is the Son of God and has the power to do it</li> <li>• But He doesn’t because He knows this is God’s Promised plan to save His people.</li> <li>• Jesus loves us so much that He doesn’t alter God’s plan.</li> <li>• Jesus dies on the cross for you and me, taking all of our sin and washing us clean. (Romans 6:3-5)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus, by rising from the dead, has broken the power that sin and death have over us.</li> <li>• Jesus gives us eternal life in His name.</li> <li>• We too don’t have to be afraid because Jesus is always with us!</li> <li>• What Good News to we have to share with others? How do we do that?</li> </ul>
